

Dennis Kilgallon

Dennis Kilgallon is an internationally renowned sculptor, has exhibited in gardens at Chelsea, Hampton Court, Gardeners World Live and Grand Designs Live. Inspired by the landscape, architecture, antiquity and mythology Dennis Kilgallon's sculpture is unique and thought provoking.

The last 14 years, working from his studio at Kirkharle Courtyard, have been spent creating large ceramic sculptures. The most recent large piece (14 feet high) formed the central point of a sensory garden designed for Hadrian Special School (Early Years) in Newcastle upon Tyne. Dennis also spent teaching time with the children. Recent year long exhibition at the Walled Garden at Wallington Hall, Northumberland.

He exports and exhibits internationally and has a working relationship with several galleries and works on collaborative ventures with other artists. He has worked with art students, to help initiate projects, coaching and mentoring them through the process of producing a wide range of ideas. Since November 2014 based at a new studio and gallery in Whitfield, Northumberland. Now working mainly on smaller models to be produced in bronze. His new range is limited edition only and commissions are welcomed.

The larger ceramic pieces, for which Dennis had built up his reputation and following, are no longer being made. However, there are a few of these sculptures left to purchase and are displayed to advantage in the beautiful courtyard and garden area here at South Barn, Whitfield.
